

ghost and pumpkin appliqué

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materials

- *National Nonwovens WoolFelt**:
 - No. 0729 Pea Soup, an exact 10-1/2" x 5-3/4" piece
 - No. 1000 Black, a 13" x 8" piece
 - No. 1102 Antique White, a 5" x 8" piece
 - No. 0660 Copper Kettle, a 2" x 8" piece
 - No. 0730 Moss, a 1" x 2" piece
- Embroidery floss to match and contrast WoolFelt colors
- *Duncan Enterprises Aleene's Original Tacky Glue*, embroidery needle, freezer paper, iron and ironing surface, light box or well-lit window, pencil, scissors (paper and fabric), straight pins

*WoolFelt kits available through Cabin Creek Designs.

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instructions

Note: Please read all instructions before beginning. Finished size of piece is approximately 12" x 7".

1. To make templates, place freezer paper shiny side down onto patterns and, using pencil and light box or well-lit window, trace shapes. Trace each piece separately and be sure to label each piece.
2. Cut out templates on traced line.
3. Place freezer paper templates shiny side down onto appropriate WoolFelt and press with iron on rayon setting. Let cool, then carefully cut out WoolFelt shapes. Leave freezer paper on WoolFelt shapes until you are ready to place them.
4. Cut one 10-1/2" x 5-3/4" rectangle from Pea Soup WoolFelt.
5. Trace half pointed background onto freezer paper, then flip it over and trace other half. Using iron on rayon setting, press freezer paper template onto Black WoolFelt.
6. Carefully cut one background piece, then use remaining Black WoolFelt to cut out five bats, six eyes, and three mouths. (**Tip:** I find it easier to cut out the eyes and mouths freehand.) Cut one of each ghost from Antique White WoolFelt. Cut one of each pumpkin from Copper Kettle WoolFelt. Cut four stems from Moss WoolFelt.

7. Remove freezer paper and place the three ghosts onto Pea Soup background. Ghosts are placed approximately 1/2" from bottom edge and approximately 1-1/4" from each side edge of Pea Soup WoolFelt. Pin to secure, then straight stitch ghosts using one strand of matching embroidery floss.

8. Overlap pumpkins, referring to color photo as needed, and pin in place. Slip stems in behind pumpkins about 1/4". Place a tiny dab of Tacky Glue under stems and pumpkins to hold in place. Let glue dry, then, using one stand of matching embroidery floss, whipstitch stems and pumpkins.

9. Place ghosts' eyes and mouths, and bats. Secure with a small dab of Tacky Glue, then straight stitch using matching embroidery floss.

10. Center Pea Soup piece onto pointed Black background and pin to secure. Using one strand of black embroidery floss, blanket stitch all around Pea Soup WoolFelt, catching Black WoolFelt.

11. Lightly press finished piece on wrong side.

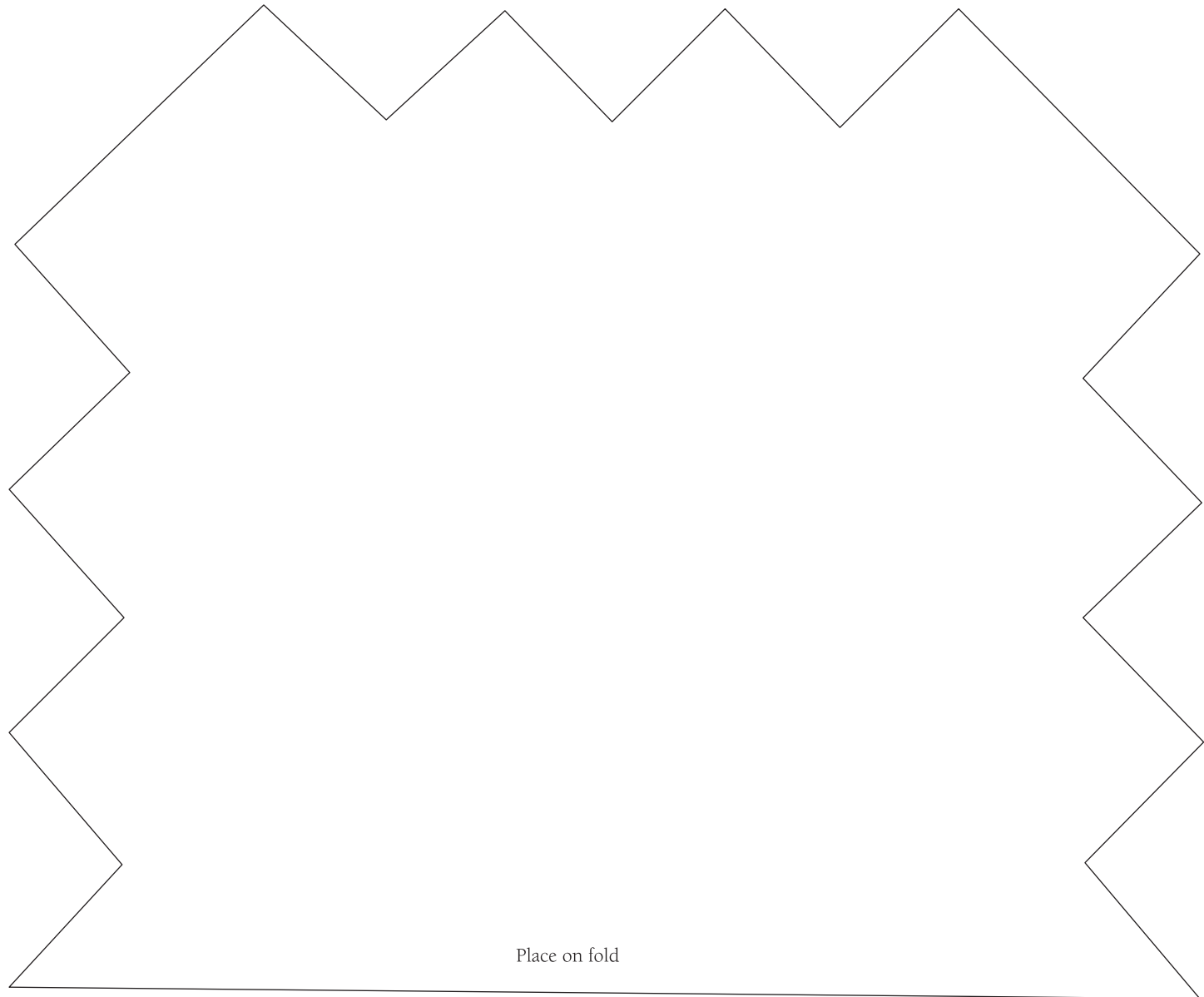
